The Board had a discussion centered on the Student Activity Fee structure.

- Possibility of \$75-\$80 fee per Tier I activity at RHS rather than the \$100 proposed fee for Tier I activities
- Difficult to find middle ground District in need of increased revenues based upon budget restrictions In order to continue to offer the array of extra-curricular an increase in fees is necessary.
- Review of coaching staff vs. activity enrollment needs
- Collected approximately \$80,000 in 2009-2010
- Need to establish long-term fee structure so parents will know what they will be faced with
- Mr. Mayer complimented FFT and noted that a tiered structure is a good answer to complaints about a "one-size fits all" approach.
