**IV. MOTION TO RESUME PUBLIC SESSION**

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**V. BOARD PRESIDENT’S REPORT – Mr. Mike Reca**

Mr. Reca recognized Band Director Birch Wilson. Mr. Wilson introduced Dave Doran of the Robbinsville Irish Heritage Association who presented a plaque and donation in the amount of \$400 to the Raven Regiment, the Robbinsville High School Marching Band. These funds will be used to offset the cost of the band’s upcoming trip to Pearl Harbor. The Board appreciates the Association’s generosity.

Athletic Director Curtis Wyers recognized the participants of Robbinsville High School’s spring athletic teams. He highlighted the successes of individual team members and reported on the accomplishments of each team. Additionally Wyers noted that over the past five years, 110 Robbinsville graduates have gone on to continue their athletic careers in college. This year more than 40 seniors will continue playing their sport(s) at the college / university level, 10 of whom will play for NCAA Division I schools.

**VI. SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT – Dr. Steven J. Mayer**

Dr. Mayer thanked Mr. Wyer’s for his dedication to the sports program and noted that the value Robbinsville athletes place on excellence both on and off the sports field reflect a culture of high expectations.

Dr. Mayer moved on to present the Annual District Report on Violence and Vandalism and the Annual Report on Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying. A Board member requested a breakdown of bullying incidents by grade level and, if possible, by gender.

**VIII. SCHOOL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR’S REPORT – Mr. Robert DeVita**

Mr. DeVita reported that, again this year, Robbinsville’s Transportation Department has been ranked #2 in Mercer County in terms of efficiency. He also said that, to date, the district has avoided \$440,000 in costs related to energy consumption. Dr. Mayer said that it is this kind of savings which has allowed us to fill 17.5 positions (10 in 2011-2012 and 7.5 for upcoming 2012-2013) of the 26 positions that were eliminated two years ago due to budget cuts.

**X. COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**A. COMMUNITY RELATIONS – Mrs. Sharon DeVito**

Mrs. DeVito reported that the Community Relations Committee is working on several initiatives related to the December 2012 referendum:

- Community meetings – PRMS November 12 / RHS November 26
- Important message – Conveying to residents that in 2013 4<sup>th</sup> grade class to be divided between Sharon and PRMS
- July 3<sup>rd</sup> planning meeting

**B. EDUCATION, DEVELOPMENT & POLICY – Mrs. Faith Silvestrov**

Mrs. Silvestrov reported on the following matters discussed at the June meeting of the Education, Development & Policy Committee.

- Preschool Curriculum Audit and Review– *Tools of the Mind*
- Summer curriculum work to address Common Core Standards and increase rigor / engagement: Geometry, Physics, Biology, AP World History, World History, English II, Spanish, French
- Curriculum for board approval: Digital Fabrication, AP Psychology
- New assessment for grades K, 2, 4, 6 - NWEA's MAP (Measures of Academic Progress)
- Online assessment that adapts to each student's proficiency level / Math and Literacy / Administered in fall and spring to measure academic growth over the school year
- Teacher Evaluation Task Force - June 12<sup>th</sup> meeting / Groups of teachers researched approved models for Teacher Evaluation and presented their findings to colleagues to determine whether we can design our own internal Teacher Evaluation system to meet the requirements of the new state initiative.

### **Comment**

In answer to a question about the Student Code of Conduct by a member of the public, Board President Mike Reca said that after the annual retreat scheduled to take place on July 12, the Board will appoint an ad hoc committee to review and discuss the potential for revision of the current code.

### **C. PERSONNEL – Mrs. Florence Gange**

Mrs. Gange reported on the following Personnel matters:

- Review regular personnel agenda and of new recommendations for hire
- Director of Special Services search – Still in process / An Interim Director, Susan DiDonato, a retired Director from West Windsor-Plainsboro is being recommended. Depending upon her availability, Mrs. DiDonato will serve for the months it will take to conduct a new search or complete the school year enabling the district to maintain positive momentum on current initiatives.
- Contract Discussion – Assistant Superintendent and School Business Administrator / 2.5% increase / The School Business Administrator will receive an additional non-pensionable stipend based upon revenue opportunities or consulting work at a rate of 10% of any related fee paid to the district
- RED Bonuses - \$110 per person, total of \$330, for the three site manager of the R.E.D. program
- Special Olympics Coaching Stipend – \$3,550 – To coach approximately 10 student participants

### **D. FINANCE, FACILITIES, & TRANSPORTATION – Mrs. Carol Boyne**

In Mrs. Boyne's absence, Mr. Kochberg reported on the following matters discussed during the meeting of the FFT committee:

- Field House - Two community members of the Robbinsville Raven Red Zone Club presented a concept idea for future board consideration to address the weight room, indoor practice, sports storage, concession stand and restroom limitations in the high school and broader community. The committee was clear that district bonding is a very unlikely option.
- Transportation Bids
- Year-End Close Out
- Food Service - Likely to require price increase at all three schools due to increase in food costs and increasing regulation / FFT has requested Chartwells to evaluate a few alternative options / Final recommendations expected in July
- R.E.D. - Merit pay for a few R.E.D. employees related to start-up and extra effort work.
- RHS Black Box - Roof issues – warranty company is evaluating / Exterior wall – General Contractor will remove sections of the wall to determine if the source of the problem is installation related
- Board Retreat Recommended Topics - Tuition Students/School Choice / Referendum Contingency / Student Code of Conduct / Staffing Model – Gaps impeding progress

## **E. NEGOTIATIONS – Mr. Thomas Halm**

In Mr. Halm's absence, President Reca reported on the status of negotiations with WTEA and indicated that briefs are due July 1 but that the deadline can be extended by up to 45 days. The Negotiations Committee is hoping for resolution by Labor Day. Mr. Reca also reported that negotiations with the administrators are under way.

## **XI. HEARING OF THE PUBLIC**

### **A. JANEANE CURRAN**

Mrs. Curran asked about the status of the Student Code of Conduct and the process involved in deciding upon and implementing revisions.

Mr. Reca said that the Code of Conduct will be discussed during the Board Retreat but that no related action would be taken at that time. After its inception, the ad hoc committee will hold a forum with parents and students as a way to gather feedback. Recommendations for revision of the code will be presented to the Ed. Policy Committee and then to the full Board for adoption. The process will take place over the course of the next few months with implementation in place for the winter sports season.
